How to find us

- *Metro:* Stop "Arts-Loi". Our offices are 50m from the metro exit ("Avenue des Arts" exit, then turn left immediately). The entrance to 28 rue de la Loi is next to the restaurant "Exki".
- *Train :* From the station Schuman, either walk to rue de la Loi (in the

direction of the centre of town) or 2 stops on the metro to "Arts-Loi", direct line 1A or 1B). From the station Midi (arrival station for Thalys and Eurostar trains), take the direct metro line Simonis to "Arts-Loi".

- *Car* : Fee paying car park on rue de la Loi opposite our office.

How to find us:

- *Metro* : Rue Cabanel is opposite the metro stop "Cambronne" on line 6, on the right as you exit, or further down Boulevard Garibaldi after exiting the stop "La Motte Picquet-Grenelle" (lines 6, 8, and 10).
- *Train* : From the station Montparnasse, take the metro line 6 in the direction "Etoile".
- *Car* : Take the south exit "Porte de Versailles" off the ring road, and there is parking available at Place Cambronne.
